The Transfer Station is closed on all legal holidays but open the following day, except Sundays, and the day after Thanksgiving.

NOTE: The gate will close 15 minutes before the above times.

Annual stickers are required and should be purchased in the Clerk's Office each June for July 1.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous waste is collected twice a year. **Please call the Selectmen's Office at 860-542-5829 for details & tickets.**

Products that are corrosive (acids, alkaline), flammable, reactive or toxic are considered hazardous.

Items to bring to a hazardous waste collection day include:

Oil based paints, thinners, stains, household chemicals, yard & garden chemicals, old pills, medicines, 20 lb propane tanks, fluorescent/low energy bulbs

Note: Latex or water-based paints can be opened to allow the paint to dry; cat litter can be added to soak up paint. Residue and paint cans can be thrown in the garbage.

WHAT TO TAKE TO THE TRANSFER STATION

MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE (MSW)

- Household Rubbish/Garbage
Ordinary garbage ONLY - Must be contained in plastic bags
- Electronics

OTHER ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Appliances
- Wood (3' x 3' or smaller)
- Latex paint (dried in can)
- Brush up to 3" in diameter for brush pile
- Leaves – for compost pile
- Metals

NOT ACCEPTABLE

Bricks, concrete blocks, concrete, stone, asphalt, propane tanks, stumps, logs, low energy/florescent bulbs

R E C Y C L A B L E S

Commingled food and beverage containers, washed clean, including:

- Clear, brown and green glass
- Steel and aluminum cans (no paint, pesticides or other hazardous wastes containers)
- Clean aluminum foil
- #1 - #7 Plastic containers up to 3 gallons
- Gable top plastic coated paper containers up to one gallon, such as milk and juice containers, caps removed
- Single serve milk and juice boxes, straws removed

Commingled paper products including:

- Newspapers/newspaper inserts
- Junk mail/office paper
- Mixed paper
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Corrugated cardboard – folded flat with staples, tape and straps removed
- Cereal boxes (liners removed), shoe boxes & pasta boxes (windows removed)

Waste Oil

Please do not mingle recyclables with your garbage. It adds to our weight and hauling costs.

BULKY WASTE

Includes such items as:

- Construction demolition – sheet rock, shingles, etc.
- Large furniture
- Mattresses/Box springs – 1 ticket
- Anything that cannot be burned

FEE STRUCTURE

STICKERS MUST BE AFFIXED TO THE PASSENGER'S SIDE OF THE WINDSHIELD

- Annual sticker \$35/vehicle
- Bulky waste tickets \$20.00/ticket
- Passenger car 1 ticket
- Tires (car – 16" max.) \$2/tire
- Appliances with Freon \$10/item
(air conditioners, refrigerators, dehumidifiers)

The amount of bulky waste transported by the average passenger car or the equivalent by a larger vehicle will be charged accordingly by the attendant.

Passenger car	1 ticket
½ & ¾ ton pickup	2 tickets
1 ton pickup	4 tickets
1 ton dump truck	6 tickets
Up to 6' long trailer	2 tickets
Single & dual axle dump truck/trailer over 1 ton	4 tickets per cubic yard
